Northeast Detectives seek assistance in area burglaries

Narrative:

Northeast Area detectives are seeking the public's assistance in identifying and locating two suspects involved in taco trailer burglaries. The locations listed above show the primary suspect on surveillance video burglarizing the taco trailers. The suspects could possibly be responsible for burglaries in other areas of the city. It is believed that the suspects are using a vehicle to commit the crimes, however at this time APD does not have a description of the vehicle.

The primary suspect is described as:

Hispanic Male
18-25 years of age
Has a goatee and long sideburns
Medium build

The second suspect appears to be a Hispanic male and is heavy set.
